A WINE WHICH I ALWAYS MAKE IN THE SAME WAY, YEAR AFTER YEAR, WITHOUT FEAR. A WINE MADE AS IF TIME WERE CYCLICAL AS OPPOSED TO LINEAR. EVEN IF TIME WERE INFINITE I WOULD EVERY HARVEST MAKE THIS WINE IN EXACTLY THIS WAY.

70% MALBEC

30% PETIT VERDOT

1.100M (3,609 FT.)

NUMBER OF BOTTLES:

VINEYARD:

PERGOLA-TRAINED VINES MORE THAN 30 YEARS OLD, AT THE FOOT OF THE ANDES. LOOSE COMPOSITION SOIL WITH GOOD DRAINAGE. THE PRUNING, IRRIGATION AND CANOPY ARE MANAGED SO AS TO OBTAIN GRAPES OF LOW YIELDS AND HIGH QUALITY. SUCH MANAGEMENT INCLUDES THE RESTRICTION OF IRRIGATION AMOUNTS, AND THE REMOVAL OF SHOOTS AND BUNCHES FROM THE VINE.

HARVEST:

IN SMALL PLASTIC BINS AT THE END OF MARCH.

WINEMAKING:

MADE WITHOUT FEAR, MADE EXACTLY AS I WOULD MAKE IT IF I KNEW I WOULD BE FORCED TO REPEAT THIS WINE INFINITE TIMES THROUGHOUT ETERNITY...
